**ADVENTUROUS DOCUMENTARY FILM REACHES OUT TO YOUNG PEOPLE
AND FAMILIES, INVITING THEIR OBJECTIVE VIEWS ABOUT FAITH**

The film is directed by award-winning filmmaker Steven Scaffidi of Ghost Rider Pictures who will attend the event and answer questions about the movie following the screening.

"The Sojourners" tells the story about the filmmaker, Scaffidi, and his son Steven who take a pilgrimage with close to 50 young adults to the town of Medjugorje in Bosnia-Herzegovina where Mary, the Mother of Jesus, has reportedly been appearing and giving messages for over 30 years to visionaries. Along the way Scaffidi and his son clash over the purpose of the trip and whether or not the visionaries are truly receiving messages from the Blessed Mother. While many on the trip are devout believers, some others have their doubts and were even coaxed into going on the pilgrimage by their parents in order to get their lives back on track. This is an honest film - not a pious one, but it's not irreverent either. It's just real.

"The Sojourners" will appeal not just to Catholics, and not even just to believers, but to anyone. The film challenges anyone who has a heart closed to faith or a heart which judges others to be open, to listen, to pray, to love, to be real. **New Orleans Archbishop Gregory Aymond gave the film two thumbs up by saying, "It's a great movie! It truly is a story of discipleship!"**

This unique screening is a family event and will take place on **Day and Date** at the **Name of Location** located at **Street Address, City, State, Zip Code**. Following the screening there will be a film festival style Q and A with the film's producer/director Steven Scaffidi.
